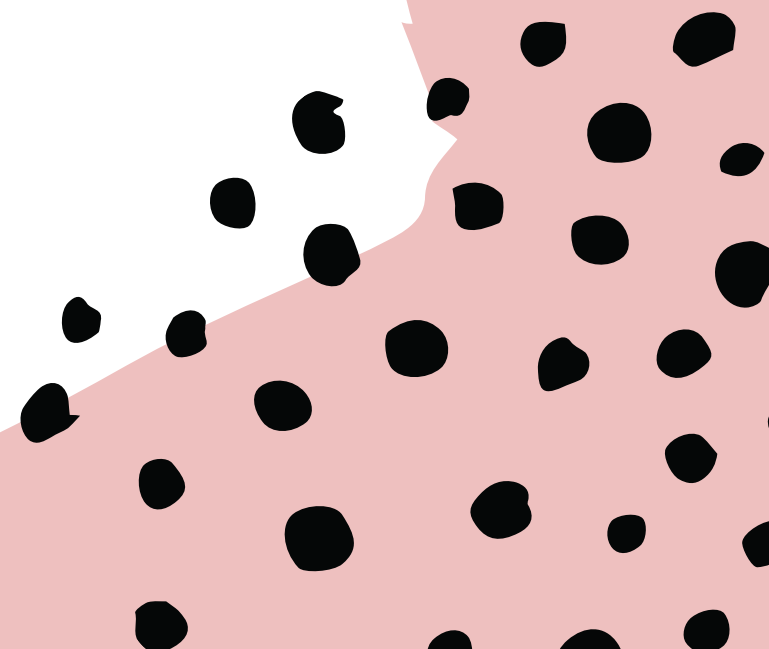

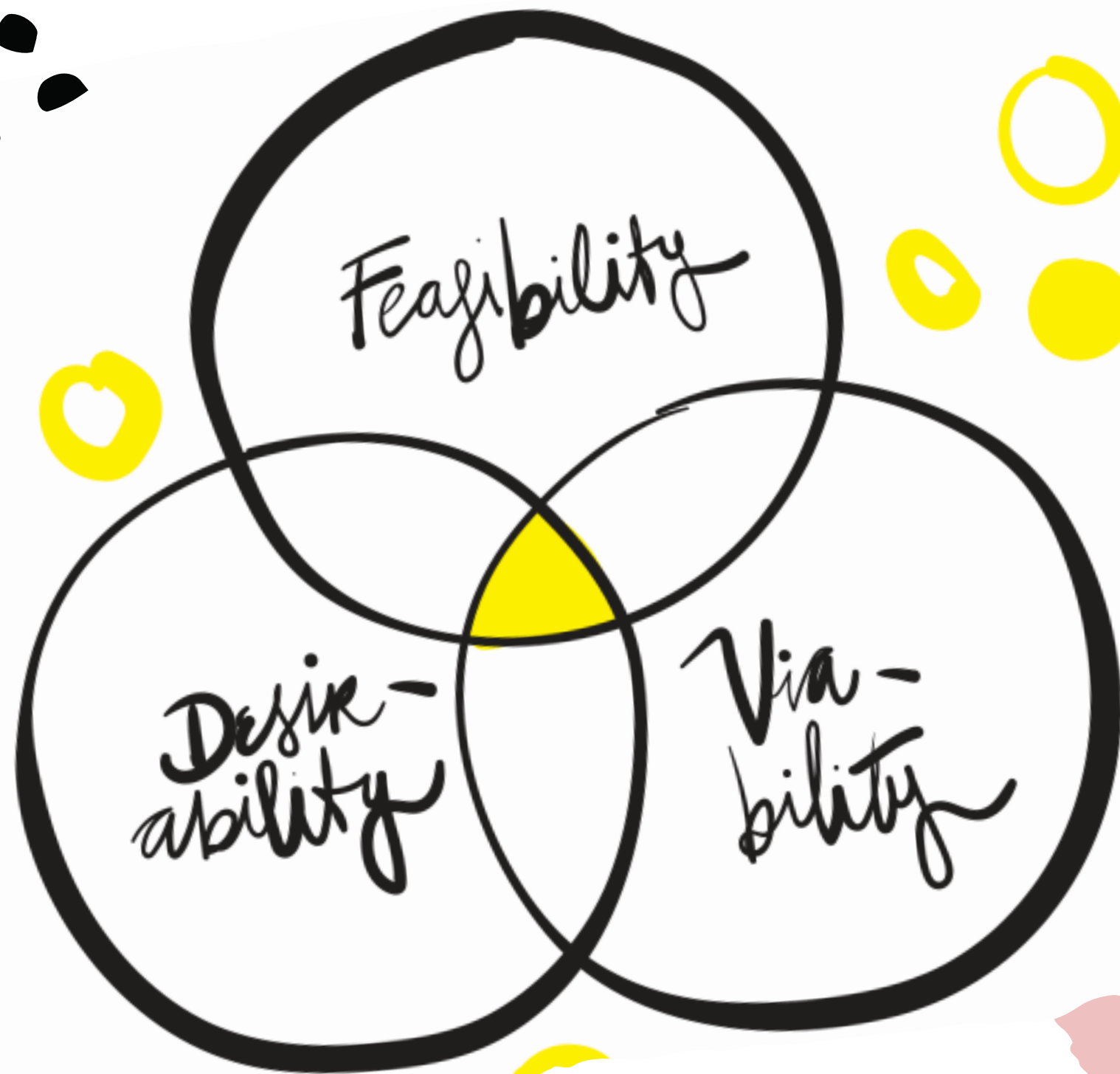
WHAT

Design thinking is a mindset that helps you solve problems creatively.

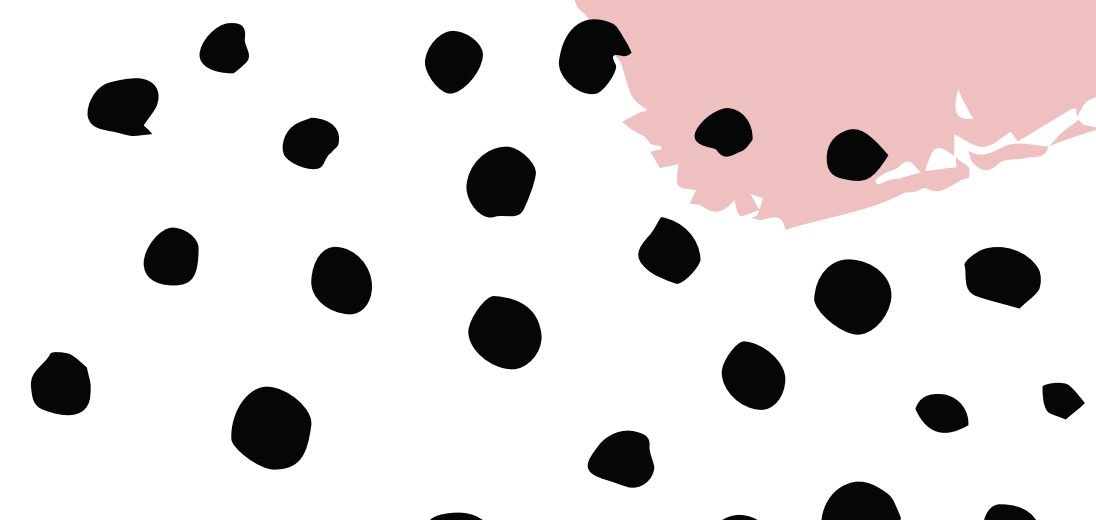
WHY

= people love your products!

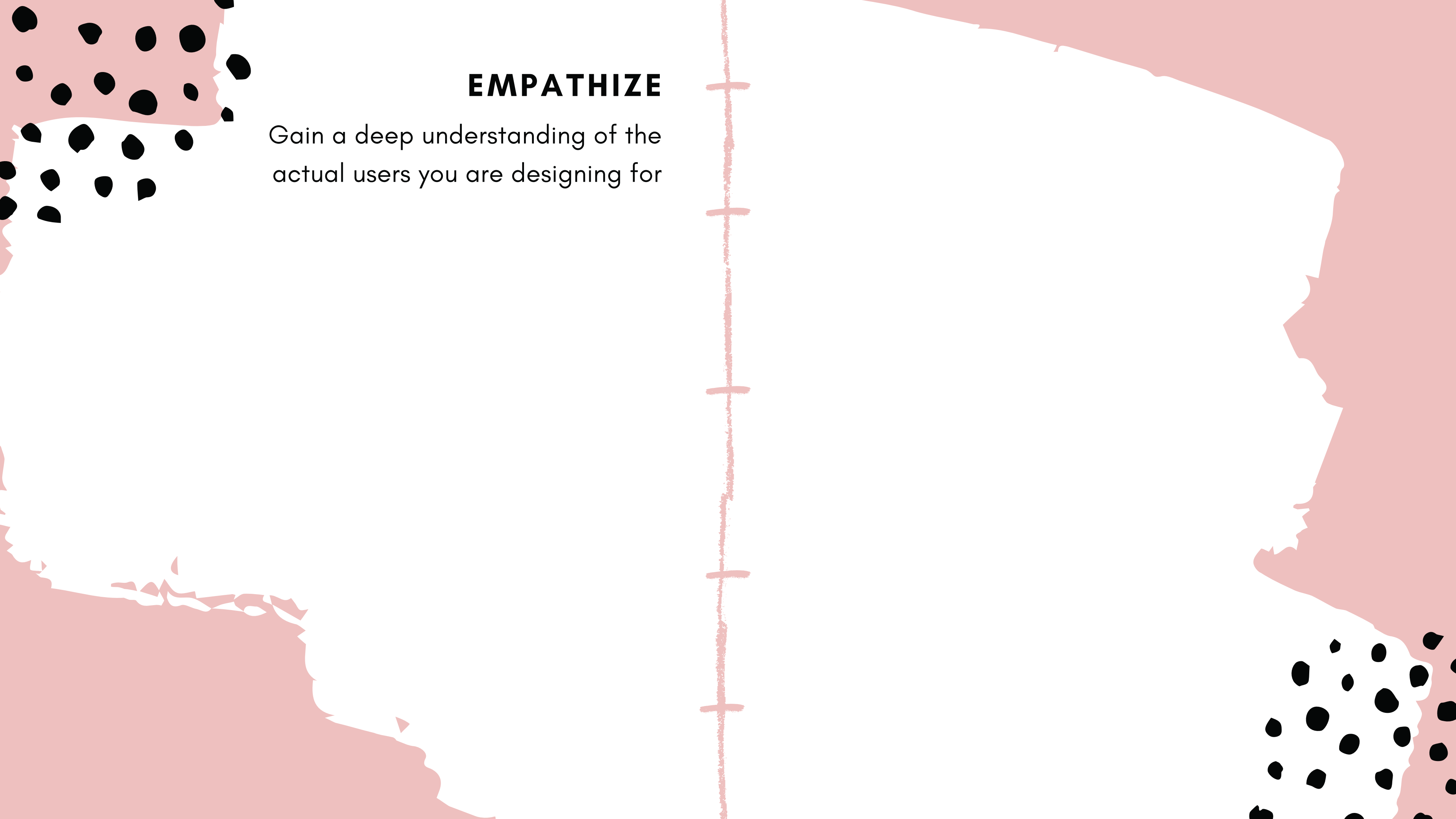


We want to get to that sweet spot on the intersection of desirability, feasibility, and viability.

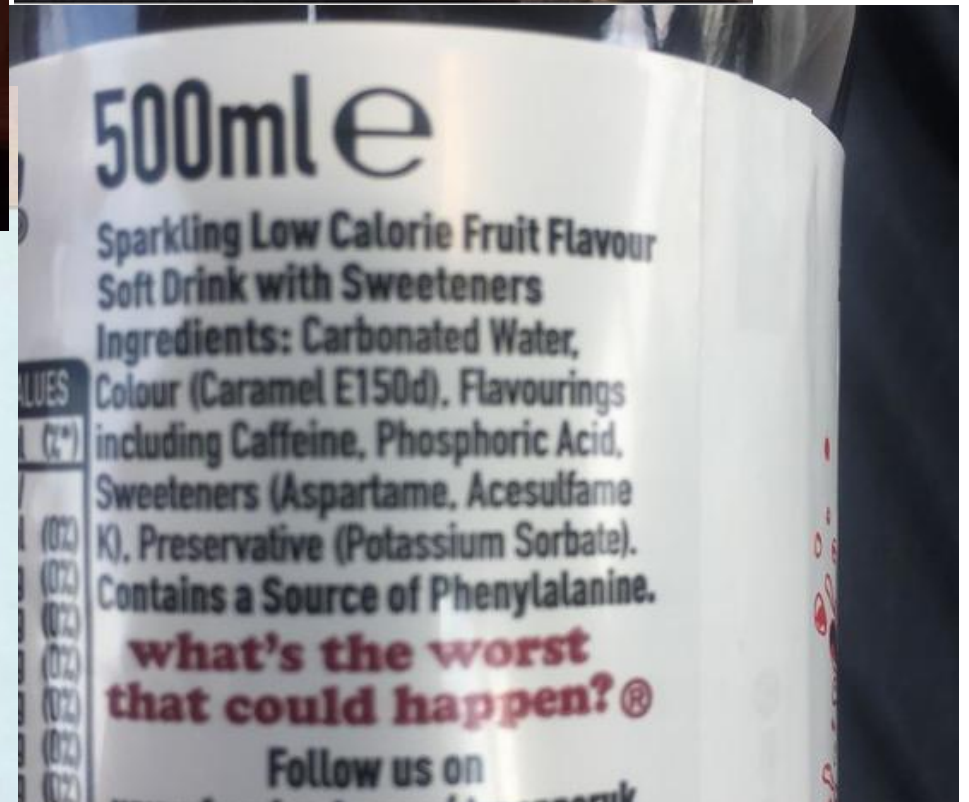
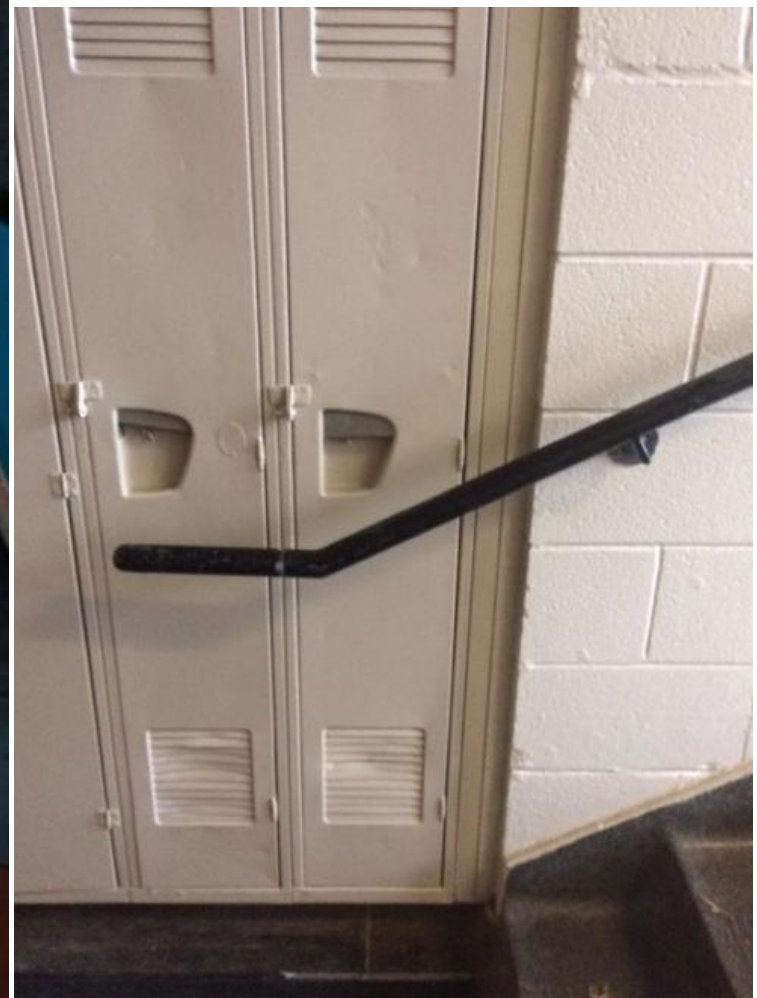
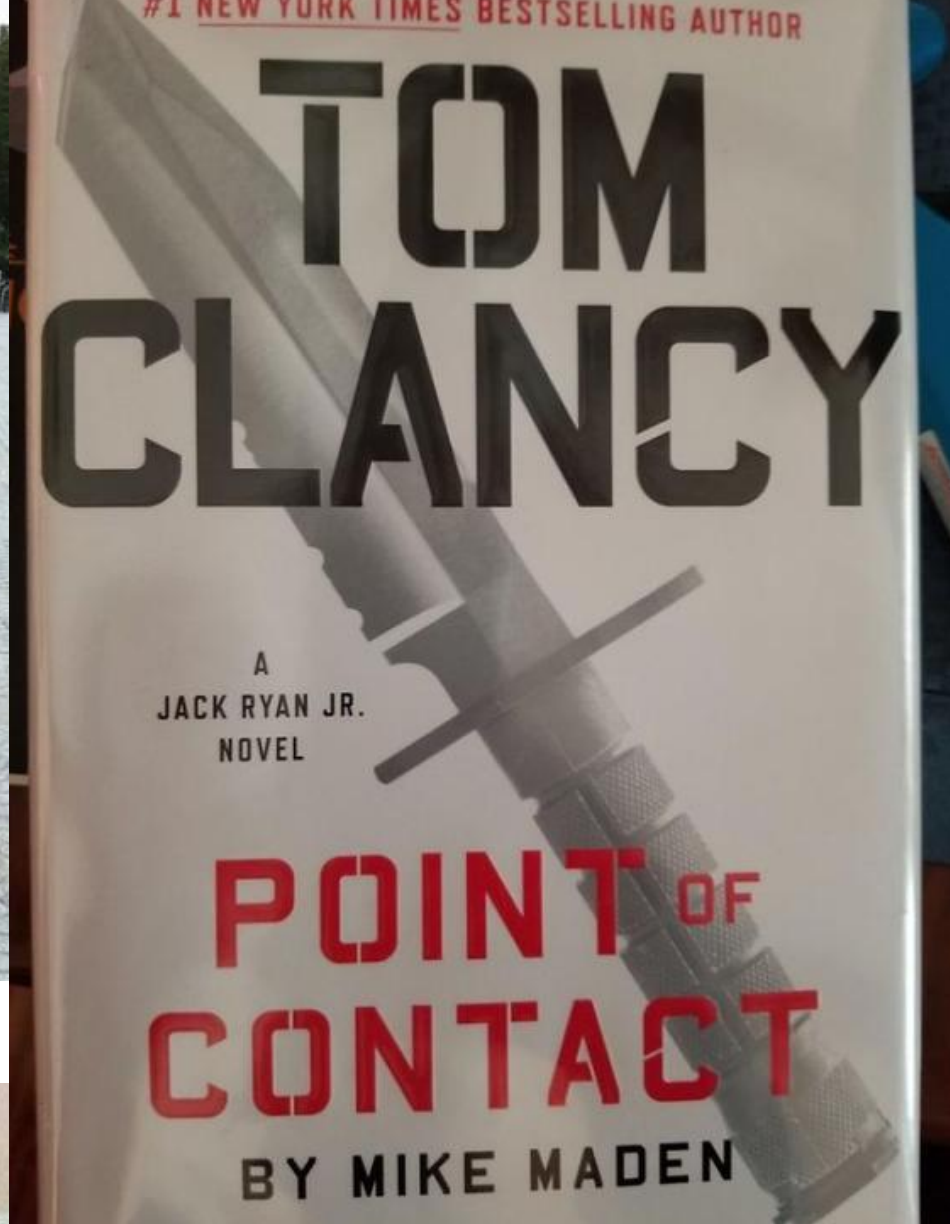
